


## How to make your Festive Fortune Teller



Cut along the dotted line



Fold a corner into the centre



Do the same for the other corners so it looks like this



Turn it over



Again, fold a corner into the centre




Repeat for the other corners so it looks like this



Fold and unfold in half this way...



...and this way



Insert your thumb and index finger on both hands under the flaps beneath the fortune teller and you're ready to play!

## Rules of play

- With the four coloured squares showing on top, get your player to pick one. Spell out the word while pulling the fortune teller in opposite directions with each letter
- Next get the player to pick one of the numbers that they see inside the fortune teller and count out the number while pulling the fortune teller in opposite directions with each number
- Finally, get the player to pick one of the symbols they can see that appeals to them. Lift the flap to reveal which reindeer they are!
